ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF VINCENT, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. It shall be unlawful and be a crime against the Town of Vincent under this ordinance, for any person to do any act or acts, or to omit to do or refrain from doing any act or acts within the Town of Vincent or within the police jurisdiction thereof, the doing of which is a misdemeanor under the laws of the State of Alabama.

SECTION TWO. Any person who is convicted under Section one (1), hereof, shall be punished by fine, not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment at hard labor upon the streets or public works or in the workhouse or house of correction in the Town of Vincent not exceeding six months (6 mos.), one or both; and in the event any fines or costs are not presently paid, the Mayor of the Town shall sentence the offender, or person, this in default to work out the fine and costs at hard labor upon the streets of public works, or in the workhouse or house of correction of the Town aforesaid, and the persons so sentenced to hard labor shall be allowed one dollar (\$1.00) for each day's services so performed.

SECTION THREE. If any clause, section or sections of this ordinance be subsequently declared invalid or unconstitutional as abridging any State or Federal law or any State or Federal Constitution, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect any remainder of this ordinance.

SECTION FOUR. Said Town of Vincent having a population of less than two (2) thousand (1,000) inhabitants, as shown by the last Federal Census, notice of the adoption of this ordinance shall be given by posting notices thereof at three public places one of which shall be the Town Hall or Post Office of Said Town.

ORDINANCE "Misdemeanor" 101-

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF VINCENT, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. It shall be unlawful and be a crime against the Town of Vincent, Alabama under this Ordinance, for any person to do any act or acts, or to omit to do or refrain from doing any act or acts within the Town of Vincent or within the police jurisdiction thereof, the doing of which is a misdemeanor under the laws of the State of Alabama Code of Alabama 1940, recompiled 1958.

SECTION TWO. Any person who is convicted under Section One (1), hereof, shall be punished by fine, not to exceed Two hundred dollars (200.00) or by imprisonment at labor upon the streets or public works or in the house of correction in the Town of Vincent, Alabama not exceeding six months, (6), one or both, and in the event any fines or costs are not presently paid, the Recorder of the Town of Vincent shall sentence the offender, or person, this in default to work out the fine and costs at labor upon the streets of public works or house of correction of the Town aforesaid.

SECTION THREE. If any clause, section or sections of this ordinance be subsequently declared invalid or unconstitutional as abridging, any State or Federal law or any State or Federal Constitution, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect any remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION FOUR. Said Town of Vincent having a population of less than two thousand as shown by the last Federal Census, notice of the adoption shall be given by posting notices thereof at three public places one of which shall be in the Town Hall of Vincent, The Gas Board Office of the Town of Vincent and the Post Office of the Town of Vincent, Alabama
