

## O R D I N A N C E

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF VINCENT, ALABAMA  
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Any person or persons owning or having the possession, custody or control of any live stock, who unlawfully or allows, cause to be allowed, or knowingly permits the same to run or be at large in the corporate limits of the Town of Vincent or the police jurisdiction thereof, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction, shall be fined not less than double the damages sustained by the injured party or parties, but in no case more than fifty dollars, one-half the fine to go to the injured party or parties, the fine to be paid in lawful money of the United States; and may also be imprisoned in the Town jail or such other place of confinement as the Town shall designate for a term not exceeding six months, at the discretion of the court trying the case.
