

ORDINANCE NUMBER _____

AN ORDINANCE PLACING A CURFEW UPON PUBLIC AREAS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF VINCENT, ALABAMA; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF VINCENT, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful for any person to loiter in any public street or any other public place within the city limits of Vincent, Alabama, between the hours of 11:30 P. M. of any day and the hour of sunrise of the following day.

SECTION 2: Any person convicted of violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and may also be sentenced to hard labor or imprisonment in the City Jail for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days, one or both.

SECTION 3: If any section, clause or provision of this ordinance should be held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such holdings shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion which do not in and of itself invalid or unconstitutional.
