ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF VINCENT, ALABAMA,  
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That every person, firm, company, corporation or association who shall engage in any business, vocation, occupation, profession, trade or calling hereinafter enumerated, or who shall exercise any privilege for which a license tax is required within the corporate limits of the Town of Vincent, or within the police jurisdiction thereof, shall pay to the Clerk of said Town for the exercise of such privilege the amounts hereinafter provided, and in addition, shall where required, make such reports and give true statements of the gross amounts of business done, upon which such license or privilege tax may be determined, and shall comply with the provisions of this Ordinance.

Merchants, every person, corporation or association engaged in merchandising; (a) where the maximum amount of stock on hand at any time during the preceding year (or if the applicant is beginning business, the amount of stock he expects to carry) to be verified by such person or its representative, if a firm, association or corporation, under oath to the Clerk, is not over one thousand dollars, the privilege license shall be ----- \$10.50  
(b) When such stock is over one thousand dollars, the tax shall be \$1.00 on each additional thousand dollars of stock.

NOTE: The taking out of the license provided for in this paragraph shall not exclude a person doing so from paying any other license herein required.

Manufacturers of any products within said Town shall pay a license on their gross sales at the following rate:

Annual Gross Sales up to \$15,000.00 -----	\$15.50
Annual Gross Sales \$15,000.00 - \$25,000.00 -----	\$30.50
Annual Gross Sales \$25,000.00 - \$50,000.00 -----	\$45.50
Annual Gross Sales \$50,000.00 - \$100,000.00 -----	\$75.50
Annual Gross Sales \$100,000.00 - \$500,000.00 -----	\$150.50
Annual Gross Sales \$500,000.00 - \$1,000,000.00 -----	\$225.50
Annual Gross Sales \$1,000,000.00 and over -----	\$350.50

All other businesses, professions, occupations or callings not herein specified shall pay a license as follows:

SECTION 2: Except as herein specifically provided, all license required in this Ordinance shall be for one year and shall become due the 1st of January, and shall be delinquent if not paid before the business is engaged in or the act done for which the same is required.

SECTION 3: All licenses shall be issued by the Clerk of the Town. There shall be a fee of fifty cents (50¢) for the issuance of each license to be paid by the licensees.

SECTION 4: If any person shall become delinquent in the payment of the license required herein, he shall pay a penalty of ten percent (10%) of the amount of the same for each month or fractional part thereof of such delinquency, such penalty to be added to the amount of the license.

SECTION 5: Any person, firm or corporation engaging in or carrying on the business or doing any of the acts for which license is hereby required, without first having paid said license, shall upon conviction, be fined not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and may be imprisoned in the Town jail or sentenced to hard labor for said Town for not more than 90 days. In the event of any appeal and conviction in the Circuit Court, the Judge of said Court on the trial of said appeal, shall have the power to impose said jail sentence or sentence to hard labor.

SECTION 6: Any person making a false affidavit to any statement required herein to be furnished to the Clerk or Mayor shall, upon conviction be punished by a fine or not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and may also be sentenced to imprisonment or hard labor for the Town for not more than 90 days.

SECTION 7: If any provisions of this Ordinance shall be held by any Court to be invalid or illegal, it shall not effect the validity of other legal provisions.

SECTION 8: If any license herein levied is by the Court declared unconstitutional, it shall in no way affect the legality or constitutionality of any other license thereunder.

SECTION 9: All Ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 10: The provisions of this Ordinance shall continue in full force and affect from year to year unless repealed or amended by subsequent act of the Town Council.
