The Mayor and Council of the Town of Vincent, Alabama upon evidence
duly submitted and considered by it, hereby finds and determines as
follows:

(1) That it is necessary to adopt ordinances from time to time
to protect the lives and property of the citizens and people of the
Town of Vincent, Alabama who reside within the Town Limits.

(2) The residents of said town who own homes and rental property
including structures appertaining thereto should be protected from
the hazards of fire in the destruction of said real property including
their homes and appertaining structures.

(3) It is the best interest of the citizens and people of the
Town of Vincent, Alabama that the following Ordinance be adopted.

ORDINANCE NO. FIRE PROTECTION-1-85

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Mayor and the City Council of the Town of Vincent, Alabama as follows:

Section 1. Except as heretofore constructed; no house, home, mobile home, house trailer, or residence or any part thereof including outside buildings or carports shall be built or constructed by any person, corporation, partnership, or other legal entity within fifty (50) feet of any other adjoining property owners' residence, home, house, mobile home, house trailer including outside buildings or carports, within the boundaries of the Town of Vincent, Alabama.

Section 2. This Ordinance is adopted by the Town Council of the Town of Vincent, Alabama as an aid in fire prevention in said town.

Section 3. If any part of this Ordinance is determined to be unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction the remaining part of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

Section 4. Any person charged with a violation and upon conviction of any section of this Ordinance may be punished by imprisonment in the Town or County Jail for not more than six (6) months or by a fine not to exceed five hundred (\$500.00) dollars one or both. The Town of Vincent in addition may enforce compliance with this Ordinance with injunctive relief in the Circuit Court of Shelby County, Alabama. Adopted on this _____ day of _____, 1985.
