

AN ORDINANCE FIXING AND ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS AND PARKING REGULATIONS IN THE TOWN OF VINCENT, ALABAMA, AND ITS POLICE JURISDICTION:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF VINCENT, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than sixty (60) miles by day and fifty (50) miles per hour by night (trucks fifty (50) miles per hour by day or night) in the following listed zones of the Town:
- (1) On Alabama Highway No. 53 (US 231) from the North Town Limit Southerly toward the Town for a distance of 4.40 miles.
  - (2) On Alabama Highway No. 25 from the West Town Limit Southeasterly toward the Town for a distance of 1.40 miles.
  - (3) On Shelby County Highway No. 60 from the East Town Limit Westerly for a distance of 0.90 miles.
- Section 2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than forty (40) miles per hour in the following listed zones of the Town:
- (1) On Alabama Highway No. 53 (US 231) from the South Town Limit Northerly toward the Town for a distance of 1.50 miles.
  - (2) On Alabama Highway No. 53 (US 231) from the junction with Alabama Highway No. 25 Northerly for a distance of 0.60 miles.
  - (3) On Alabama Highway No. 25 from the junction with Alabama Highway No. 53 (US 231) Northwesterly for a distance of 1.00 miles.
  - (4) On Shelby County Highway No. 60 from the junction with Alabama Highway No. 25 Easterly for a distance of 1.50 miles.
  - (5) On Shelby County Highway No. 25 from the East Town Limit Westerly for a distance of 2.70 miles to the junction with Alabama Highway No. 53 (US 231).
- Section 3. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than thirty (30) miles per hour in the following listed zones of the Town:
- (1) On Alabama Highway No. 53 (US 231) from a point 1.50 miles North of the South Town Limit Northerly for a distance of 1.10 miles.
- Section 4. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than twenty-five (25) miles per hour on any streets or alleys not specifically mentioned or set out herein.
- Section 5. Speed limits as described above shall apply so long as the Town Limits remain as they are this date. In the event they are extended this ordinance shall be revised to properly cover the new territory.
- Section 6. No person shall park a motor vehicle in any designated area when said prohibited area is properly marked with yellow paint and/or signed.

Section 7. In addition to all other provisions of law relating the speed and operation of motor vehicles in said Town, there is hereby adopted by the Town of Vincent, Alabama, all laws of the State of Alabama and all rules and regulations of the State Highway Department pertaining to the control of traffic and motor vehicles on highways, that are misdemeanors under the State Laws and a violation of such laws, rules and regulations in the Town of Vincent, or in the police jurisdiction thereof shall be violations of this ordinance.

Section 8. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or may be imprisoned in the municipal jail or sentenced to hard labor for the Town, for a period not exceeding ten (10) days; for a second such conviction within one year thereafter, such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or may be imprisoned in the municipal jail or sentenced to hard labor for the Town for a period not exceeding twenty (20) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment; upon a third or subsequent conviction within one year after the first conviction, such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or may be imprisoned in the municipal jail or sentenced to hard labor for the Town for a period not exceeding six (6) months, or by both fine and imprisonment.

Section 9. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 10. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
