

Councilman Wayne Lewis introduced the following Ordinance:

ORDINANCE 85 005

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR OF THE TOWN OF VINCENT, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

That the fine amounts set in the minutes of November 15, 1983 be amended to read as follows:

1. Any person convicted of the following offenses in the Municipal Court of the Town of Vincent, Alabama shall be subject to the penalties described below:

FIRST CONVICTION of Driving Under the Influence

Imprisonment in the county jail for not more than one year AND/OR

Fine not less than \$250.00 nor more than \$1,000.00 AND

The Department of Public Safety shall suspend the drivers license for 90 days AND

Mandatory completion of approved DUI Court Referral Program.

SECOND CONVICTION of Driving Under the Influence

Imprisonment for minimum of 48 hours and not more than one year

in the county jail (may include hard labor)

a) Mandatory 48 consecutive hours imprisonment OR

b) 20 days community service AND

Fine of not less than \$500.00 or more than \$2,500.00 AND

One year driver's license revocation by the Department of Public Safety.

THIRD CONVICTION of Driving Under the Influence

Imprisonment in the county jail (may include hard labor) 60 days to a year.

a) Mandatory 60 day imprisonment which cannot be probated or suspended AND

Fine of not less than \$1,000 nor more than \$5,000 AND

The Director of Public Safety shall revoke the license for 3 years.

2. All provisions contained in the minutes of November 15, 1983 of the Town of Vincent Alabama in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed.

3) This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law.
